### Dear Resident

The 32<sup>nd</sup> City of Norwich Half Marathon takes place on **Sunday 9 April 2017** starting and finishing at the Norfolk Showground.

The course will again be a single lap as this greatly reduced the impact upon you as residents on and around the route.

In order to ensure the safety of runners, marshals and spectators a road closure order will be in force for the duration of the race between 10:30 and 13:30. However, as always, we maintain access for residents and businesses when safe to do so but would ask that if at all possible, travelling along any section of the route is avoided during the times indicated overleaf.

**The map of the 2017 route is shown inside this leaflet** and is marked to break the route into separate sections showing the times each section will be impacted and traffic restrictions apply. The single lap means that we are able to re-open each section as the last runner completes that section with roads returned to normal much more quickly.

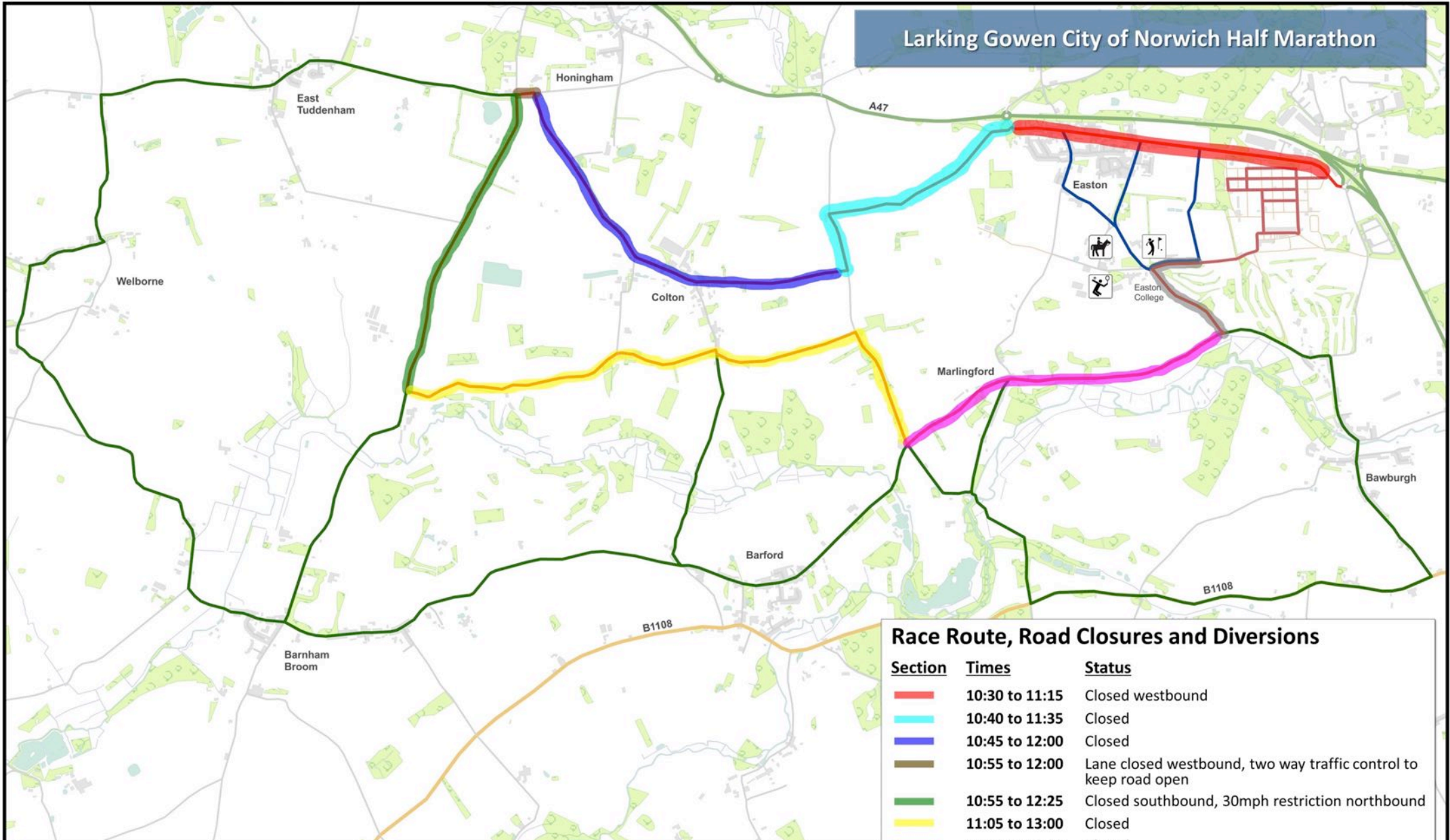
